Youth As Resources Grant Guidelines

for the 2022-2023 school year

PURPOSE

To provide financial support to projects in which youth use their skills, talents and abilities to serve or educate others.

TYPICAL GRANTS

Average of \$200. Maximum of \$500, although exceptional projects may qualify for higher levels of funding.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

Any group comprised primarily of residents of Door County, be it organized or informal, may apply.

APPLICATION PROCESS AND DEADLINES

To apply, complete the form and return on or before the due date. The important dates are as follows:

Friday, October 1, 2022	Wednesday, October 19, 2022 begins at 5:00 p.m.
Wednesday, December 1, 2022	Wednesday, December 21, 2022 begins at 5:00 p.m.
Tuesday, March 1, 2023	Wednesday, March 15, 2023 begins at 5:00 p.m.
Monday, May 2, 2023	Wednesday, May 17, 2023 begins at 5:00 p.m.

Applications must be completed by students and must be received in the office of the Door County Community Foundation by 4 p.m. on the application deadline noted above. As a part of the review process, at least one youth representative from your organization is required to present your project idea to the Reviewers at a meeting in Sturgeon Bay on the corresponding Youth Presentation date noted above. You will be informed of the location of the meeting and the specific time slot for your presentation shortly after you apply.

The Youth Presentation should not exceed 5 minutes and will be followed by questions. High school age students are expected to make their presentation without any assistance from an adult. Middle school age children may be prompted and assisted by an adult. Elementary school age children should be available to answer questions, but an adult may make the presentation.

Applicants will be informed of the final decision within 2 days after their Youth Presentation is made. *Grantees are required to return for a future committee meeting to provide a brief final report of their project outcomes.*

PAYMENT OF GRANT FUNDS

Applicants that apply under the umbrella of a 501(c)(3) public charity, school or government agency will receive a check payable to the organization shortly after the grant is approved. Applicants that do not operate under the umbrella of a charity, school or government agency will be reimbursed for expenses after receipts and other documentation are presented as proof of actual expenditures.
